1909 Hamilton County's first hospital, Harrell Hospital and Sanatorium, opens.



1968 Intensive care unit opens.

1987 Riverview adds 82,000 square foot west wing.

1989 Women's Center and Hamilton County's first permanent cardiac catheterization laboratory opens.

1993 Community Health Clinic and Cancer Center opens.

1994 Sleep/Wake Center opens.

2003 Women's Pavilion opens with new and expanded Maternity Center and Center for Breast and Diagnostic Services.



2012 Minimally invasive endovascular procedures begin being performed in the catheterization lab at Riverview.

2013 Riverview becomes the only hospital in Hamilton County to earn the prestigious Commission on Cancer accreditation.

1951 New hospital opens along the banks of the White River, and is renamed Riverview Hospital a year later.

1967 Riverview expands, adding 5-story patient building.



1991 Surgery Center opens.

1992 Riverview begins performing total joint replacement surgeries and opens 16-bed acute rehabilitation unit.

2002 First open heart surgery in Hamilton County is performed at Riverview.

2006 Riverview unveils new 24,000 square foot Emergency Center.



2011 Riverview becomes one of the first hospitals in the state to perform anterior approach hip replacements.

2012 Riverview begins performing advanced orthopedic and spine procedures.
